Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. When can we come to the campus and when will the hostel accommodation will be provided?

Students may plan to arrive on campus from 12-Nov-2022 (Saturday) onwards. Hostel accommodation will be readily available from 12-Nov-2022 onwards. We may not be able to accommodate the students if you arrive earlier. All the students must physically report for the student induction programme (SIP) on 14th November, 2022.

- Is hostel available for every student? Are hostel rooms shared or single room?
 Yes, hostel will be provided to all the newly admitting students. Accommodation will be provided on shared basis.
- 3. Is hostel compulsory?

Yes. However, the competent authority may relax the condition on request of the student, providing sufficient and essential documents through proper channel.

- When will the first semester class work start?
 The class work will commence from 22nd November, 2022. Academic Calendar will be uploaded on Institute website.
- Is class work "online" for newly admitting students?
 No, the class work will be commenced in "OFFLINE" and in physical mode only.
- 6. What is Student Induction Programme (SIP)? Purpose of the Student Induction Program is to help new students adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self exploration.
 SIP for newly admitting students of IIITDM Kurnool is scheduled from 14th November

to 18th November, 2022. Regular class work will start only after SIP – 2022.

7. I have given my father's/guardian's email ID, but I want all the communication from the Institute to be on my personal email ID. How to change the Email ID?

During the Student Induction Programme, all the newly admitted students will be allotted the Institute Email ID. All subsequent communication will be made only through the Institute Email ID.

8. Where IIITDM Kurnool is located?

IIITDM Kurnool campus is located at Dinnedevarapadu Village, on a hilltop called "Jaganathagattu" in Kurnool district of Andhra Pradesh, close to the Nandyal-Kadapa Highway. The campus is about 20 KMs from Kurnool Airport, 12 KMs from Kurnool City Railway station and Bus Stand, and 03 KMs from G. Pulla Reddy Engineering College, Kurnool. One could get an auto from the Railway station or Bus stop to IIITDM Kurnool. The autorickshaw will charge approximately Rs. 200. The important landmark in between Kurnool city and IIITDM Kurnool are 1. C-Camp 2. G. Pulla Reddy Engineering College and 3. Jaganathagattu temple. IIITDM Kurnool is located at approximately 50 meters from Jaganathagattu temple.

9. When to submit Migration Certificate, Gap Certificate (if applicable) and Transfer Certificate?

All necessary certificates (hard copies) should be submitted to the academic section during 14 to 18 November, 2022. However, all prescribed documents have to be uploaded in a <u>single .pdf file</u> "online" for verification and confirmation of admission during 04-09 November, 2022,

10. What will be the courses in the first semester?

List of all the courses along with the Time-Table will be uploaded on Institute website (shortly) and will be circulated to your Institute Email-Ids (once created).

11. Is change of branch allowed?

14. What should I do if the payment link given on Institute's website is not working?

All newly admitting students are advised to pay the Institute fee using "Online Payment Link" only. However, if the payment link is not working due to any technical reasons, in such situation you may pay the fee directly to the Institute

15. Do we need to pay the semester fee after adjusting the seat acceptance fee?

Yes. The students may please note that the final amount after adjusting the JoSAA/CSAB seat acceptance/processing fee will be uploaded on Institute website (https://iiitk.ac.in/), along with all other necessary instruction. You are advised to visit our website on regular basis.

16. What is the last date of Payment of Fee?

Last date of fee payment: 09th November, 2022 (before 2:00 PM). After the deadline, late fine @100 Rs/Day will be imposed, as per Institute Rule.

17. Please provide information regarding Scholarships and Education Loans?

The Institute encourages and facilitates students to apply for scholarships on National Scholarship Portal and other scholarships from various other agencies. Since the inception, the institute is putting every effort in implementing central sector scholarship and state government (Andhra Pradesh) schemes such as (Jagananna Vidya Deevena (Tuition Fee Reimbursement Scheme) and Jagananna Vasathi Deevena (Mess& Hostel Fee reimbursement)) for all eligible students. Scholarship and Weaker Section (Contact Number: 0851-8289129) is established to look after scholarship opportunities.

Opportunity of availing Education Loans through different banks has been scheduled during student induction programme by inviting bank personnel.

18. Can I apply for Central Sector Scholarship Schemes on the National Scholarship Portal?

Yes. All eligible students are encouraged to apply for NSP scholarships. The last date for NSP scholarships can be obtained from NSP Website. The eligible students can directly apply on the NSP website. Further, Scholarship and Weaker Section of the Institute will extend all the necessary support in this connection.

19. Can I apply for both Central and State Government Scholarship Schemes? / Can I apply for more than one scholarship scheme?

No, at any given point of time a student is allowed to apply only one scholarship scheme either to the central government or state government scheme.

20. Is it necessary to have a bank account?

It is advised to have a bank account opened in the name of the student. The Institute also facilitates the opening of Savings Bank Account for the students during student induction programme. The bank account would be helpful for receipt of scholarships etc.

21. I have recently bought a new laptop. Is it compulsory to buy a new one in the first year?

No. If a student already has a laptop, buying new laptop in not required.

22. Will the Institute provide laptop in the first year?

No. The Institute does not sell or provide laptops.

23. Could you please tell all the procedures that are to be followed by a newly admitting student?

You will be informed about all such formalities during the student induction programme. As of now, submit the necessary documents online (as prescribed and uploaded in the Institute website). These documents are essential for the verification and confirmation of your admission here at IIITDM Kurnool.

24. What is the immediate course of action?

All the newly admitting students are hereby informed that all relevant details regarding admission, procedures and other formalities will be explained during the SIP. The students have to pay the fee on or before November, 2022 (before 2:00 PM) without fail. The fee receipt and other relevant documents should be uploaded on the link mentioned in the Institute website.
